

BROOKHEAD RIDING CLUB RULES 2017

- 1 All dogs must be on a lead at all times - failure to comply will result in you being asked to leave.
- 2 At all times the show field will be deemed to be private property.
- 3 Any competitors, spectators or members refusing to leave when asked to do so will be dealt with as trespassers.
- 4 The Committee and the organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident, loss or damage to competitors, animals, vehicles or property for any reason whatsoever.
- 5 The decision of the judge on the day in all classes will be final.
- 6 Competitors must be correctly dressed in all classes. British standard skullcaps/hard hats must be worn and fastened securely at all times when mounted on the showground. Failure will incur elimination.
- 7 Galloping outside of the ring is forbidden at all times. Any member or competitor contravening this rule WILL be asked to leave and may have their membership cancelled and/or excluded from all future shows.
- 8 Any abuse to judges, stewards, organiser by any members, their handlers or representatives will result in their membership being cancelled and /or excluded from future BWRC events.
- 9 The rider or handler of any animal thought to be excessively or unnecessarily abused will be asked to leave the showground.
- 10 Stallions or colts over 2 years old which have not been gelded are not allowed on the showground under any circumstances.
- 11 Late entries will only be taken if the judge for that class agrees.
- 12 Any competitor wishing to make a complaint must do so in writing on the show day accompanied by a fee of £5. The complaint will be brought before the committee at the next meeting. If the complaint is accepted the £5 fee will be refunded.
- 13 A minimum of three shows must be attended to be eligible for the end of season points/trophies.
- 14 Entry fees will not be refunded, except when the judge of the class decides that an animal is lame or unsound. Or if the class is cancelled.
- 15 No horse or pony may compete under saddle under 4 years old.
- 16 A rider competing in lead rein classes may not enter any other non-lead rein class either with the same/different pony combination.
- 17 It is the responsibility of the owners to ensure that the animal is the correct height for their class.
- 18 BWRC/BHS memberships must be produced when making entries, otherwise the non-member rates will apply.

19 If any competitor is considered by the Committee or judge to have received assistance from outside the ring, they will be eliminated from that class.

20 Points: any objection to the allocation of points must be made before the end of the following show. The points will be available after the second show and at every show thereafter.

21 The name of the horse/pony must be kept for the entire season. If the animals name or if the rider is changed then a new set of points will be started.

22 Members may only gain points with the same combination rider/handler and horse/pony throughout the season, in all classes.

23 In the event of any dispute, the Committee decision will be final in all classes.

24 All perpetual cups and trophies presented through the season remain the property of Brookhead Riding Club. Unless otherwise stated. All perpetual cups/trophies must be returned to the Club Secretary by the last points show.
